

## ***Are you ready? Let's go sew!***

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**Style Tip:** Turn plain into pretty with designer style decorative stitching on a ready-made blouse!

The decorative stitches built into modern machines are a virtual goldmine of embellishment opportunities! Upscale a basic blouse using decorative stitches to embellish areas such as the blouse front, cuffs, and collar. Choose contrasting colors or opt for a tone on tone look. In no time at all you'll have an upscale garment you can be proud to wear. Add color coordinated lace and trims for even more pizzazz.

### **Materials and Supplies featured in this episode:**

- [Brother XV8500D Sewing and Embroidery Machine](#)
- [Brother Embroidery Thread and Bobbin Thread](#)
- [SAEMB7511](#) Embroidery needles for sewing machine
- Presser foot suitable for decorative stitching. I used foot "N."
- Removable Stabilizers such as:
  - [SA5810](#) Brother Medium Weight Tear-Away Stabilizer
  - [SA541](#) Brother Light Weight Water Soluble Stabilizer
  - Liquid fabric stiffener such as Terial Magic Fabric Spray

### **General tips:**

- This project features added decorative stitching on a ready-made blouse. Areas where the garment has interfacing are ideal for decorative stitching. However, you may need to add stabilizer for more support during the stitching process. I prefer stabilizers that are removable when finished so the blouse has no residue showing on either side of the fabric.
- Practice your decorative stitches on fabric that is very similar to your blouse. Purchase a small amount of similar fabric yardage if necessary.

- Add interfacing to your sample fabric to mimic the areas you want to embellish on your ready-made blouse.
- Use removable markers or simply use the edge of your presser foot as a guide when stitching.
- Wind a bobbin with matching decorative thread so the stitch looks good on both the right and wrong side.
- Add lace and trims as desired but be sure the trimming is compatible with laundering instructions for your garment. It is best to pre-wash all trims before stitching.
