Passport Case 6x10 Hoop



SUPPLIES NEEDED

Passport Case design <u>https://www.embroiderygarden.com/shop/in-the-hoop/passport-case.html</u>

6x10 Hoop

No Show Poly Mesh Stabilizer (lightweight cutaway)

2 fabrics were used for the sample. 1 fabric for the outside and pockets and 1 for the inside.

1 piece of <u>Pellon 988</u> 8"w x 10"h A

1 piece of fabric for the outside 8"w x 10"h B

1 piece of fabric for the inside 8"w x 10"h C

2 pieces of fabric for the pockets $8''w \times 8''h D$, **E** Fold both pieces wrong sides together to measure $8''w \times 4''h$. Press

1 piece of Fold Over Elastic (FOE) 5/8"w x 10" long

Load the file EG Passport Case Outside OR EG Passport Case Outside 2

Hoop the stabilizer

Place the batting **A** centered in the hoop. Place fabric piece **B** right side up centered on top of the batting.

Stitch Step 1. This step stitches the quilting Note **EG Passport Case Outside 2** stitches a plaid pattern which has 3 steps. You can use all one color of thread or 3 different colors.

Remove this piece from the hoop. Trim the stabilizer even with the fabric and set aside.

Load the file EG Passport Case

Hoop the stabilizer

Place fabric piece **C** right side up centered in the hoop. **Stitch Step 1.** This step bastes the fabric in place and stitches some placement lines.

Place folded piece **D** with the fold along the top 2 placement lines. The fold will be pointing towards the center of the hoop.

Stitch Step 2. This step stitches the dividing lines for the ID and credit cards.

Place folded piece \mathbf{E} with the fold along the next 2 placement lines. The fold will be pointing towards the center of the hoop.

Stitch Step 3. This step stitches the 2 sets of placement lines near the bottom of the hoop. These are the FOE placement lines.

Center the FOE right side up between the lines. Tape each cut end in place.

Stitch Step 4. This step stitches the FOE in place at both ends. It will also stitch a line near the bottom of the hoop.

Fold the quilted outside piece you stitched first wrong sides together at the center. Line up the basting stitches on the *sides* and have the folded center in the center of the hoop. Unfold the top half and pin in place at the very top and bottom of the hoop.

Stitch Step 5. This step stitches the case together.

Remove the design from the hoop. Trim around the design $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the final stitching leaving the opening longer at $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Trim the bulk from under the 2 layers that form the opening.

Turn the case to the right side through the opening. Push out the seams and corners nicely. Press the case.

Turn the raw edges in and hand stitch or use fusible tape to close the opening.

Insert passport, ID and credit card cards as shown. Fold the FOE to the front side to secure.
